Bradford's Social Concerns would like to remind you that Wisconsin will have its Fall Primary election on Tuesday, August 13th. The ballot will include two ballot measures about legislative and gubernatorial powers to appropriate money, primary races for US Senate, US Congressional representative, State Assembly, and some State Senate seats. In addition, the county District Attorney, Clerk, Treasurer, and Register of Deeds are up for election.

Your polling place and state senate and assembly districts may have changed due to redistricting. You can check your voter registration, polling place, and sample ballot at myvote.wi.gov. If you will be out of town or otherwise be unable to vote on August 13th, you can request an absentee ballot online.
